

# O'WEEK & CLUBSLAND 2023

## CLUB CONDUCT

All student groups require approval from YouX prior to any participation in O'Week or Clubsland. Stalls and displays may not be set up during O'Week or Clubsland except as part of official displays, and must receive prior approval from YouX.

### 2023 Dates

**O'Week:** Tuesday 21– Thursday 23 February

**Clubsland:** Tuesday 8– Thursday 10 August

### Other Events

Clubs are welcome to hold events such as BBQs, movie nights, and meet & greet sessions during O'Week and Clubsland, but these must not take place in the restricted zones or designated areas between 9am-5pm.

**O'Week:** These areas include the Maths Lawns and all outdoor areas unless written consent is provided by YouX.

**Clubsland:** These areas include Hub Central, Level 4 (ground level), the Eastern and Western Courtyards, Maths Lawns and Barr Smith Lawns. Clubs must adhere to all Terms and Conditions during O'Week, Clubsland, and any stalls, displays, demonstrations, and activities associated with these events. This ensures the smooth operation of the events and ensures that all clubs are treated fairly, with equal opportunity to promote themselves.

Club stalls, displays, and members during O'Week and Clubsland must not:

- Promote third-party services or products without prior written approval from YouX.
- Feature external guests without prior written approval from YouX.
- Conduct activities, or engage with students in club activities and promotions outside of official O'Week/Clubsland areas without written approval from the YouX.
- Promote or distribute materials that are offensive, discriminatory, or insensitive to fellow students.
- Engage in behaviour that is offensive or inappropriate, or that harasses or disrupts other stalls, students and staff, or will bring YouX/University or Adelaide into disrepute.

In addition, all stallholders and volunteers must remain within the boundaries of their designated stall when active. Volunteers may not advertise or distribute flyers outside of their stall.

Club stalls at O'Week and Clubsland must not feature advertising or representatives from any third-party organisations, except where YouX has granted approval.

## CLUB CONDUCT

### Breaches of Rules

If a club (including any volunteers at a club stall) is found to be in breach of these rules, they will be given one warning.

Further instances of inappropriate conduct will result in disciplinary actions including:

- Immediate removal of the club from O'Week or Clubsland;
- Ineligibility for Clubs Awards in the O'Week and Clubsland stall category;
- A mandatory disciplinary meeting between staff and the executive of the club

Depending on the severity of the situation, the club may also be prohibited from booking a stall at future events such as O'Week 2024, and may be prohibited from receiving Clubs grants for 12 months.

Clubs that establish stalls or displays without authorisation, or in non-approved spaces, will be asked to leave the area and will face immediate disciplinary actions.
