

Major Grant Guidelines 2025

Total annual amount available: \$3,000.00.

Clubs are eligible for one major grant in each calendar year, and the funding is separate to a Club's Minor Grant funding.

Purpose: Major Events that positively impact campus culture and grow the brand of YouX and the University, or provide an opportunity to otherwise positively impact the student experience.

Rules/restrictions: The event must be held on campus, unless the applicant can clearly demonstrate how that is impracticable or how it is beneficial to campus culture for this to be held in another location.

This grant will not be considered for events that are considered to have the primary purpose of fundraising for the Club.

Questions that we will ask if an application for an event is to be held off campus:

- Is there an on-campus venue that could reasonably facilitate this event/program?
- Has the applicant made every effort to secure a suitable on-campus venue?
- What are the reasons the applicant does not believe they can hold this at an on-campus venue?
- How does holding this event off-campus positively impact campus culture?

How to apply:

Applicants are required to complete the <u>online application form</u>, including a budget, and relevant quotes, and provide a breakdown of the event's purpose and impact on campus culture.

Once this has been received, the YouX Clubs and Events teams will assess the application and provide a recommendation on the viability of the event. The applicant may be asked to attend a meeting to discuss the finer details of the event plans, and for feedback to be provided on the proposed event.

Applicants must provide no less than six weeks for a Major Grant to be assessed (except for special circumstances), allowing for the YouX administration team to assist in planning, and for the Clubs Committee to assess the merit of the application. Clubs should plan sufficient time to organise and facilitate the event after the assessment has been completed and approval granted.
