Returning Officer's Report – 16 December 2024

Nominations were called for:

- April Glynn-Roe (Queer Officer) Nominated Herself
- Oscar Harding (Rural Student Officer) Nominated himself
- Edward Archer nominated Jayde Thyer (Aboriginal and Torres Strait Island Officer) based on her previous experience on the Council.

The question was raised whether Jayde could be nominated in-absentia. On interpretation of the Constitution, I deemed that there was nothing stopping this and that if Jayde were to decline the nomination, she is free to resign at any point.

As there were no further nominations, a ballot was not required.

I declared the following members elected as Executive members:

- April Glynn-Roe
- Oscar Harding
- Jayde Thyer

This satisfies section 8.e of the Constitution requiring that at least two members of the Executive identify as women, noting that the current vacant position of President could be filled by a member of any gender.
