

Below is a report on the SRC's work in achieving the KPIs and obligations as set out in the funding agreement.

As our term began on the 1st of Dec, the SRC has not established formal policies. Submissions are being made by SRC Council members to the General Secretary in preparation for our first meeting on Dec 9th.

Our training days (Dec 8-9) include a two hour Safer Campus Training, as per AUU training requirements. Members will be introduced to their roles and responsibilities and encouraged to engage seriously with their new roles.

SRC council members have informally discussed plans for O-Week, including the counter guide. The Dec 9th meeting will formally vote on what our plans for this event will look like.

SRC council members have informally raised committees they feel they are best suited to. Formal recommendations will be made via the SRC President once all members have had the opportunity to put themselves forward.

The SRC President has communicated formally with DIDA to better understand how the SRC can serve students with disabilities and mental health concerns. We hope to collaborate in the future with events targeted at mental health.

The SRC President plans to communicate shortly with Roseworthy and Waite students to reach a clearer understanding of how our SRC can serve them in 2022.

We are excited about our plans for 2022 and will update you accordingly.
